Kayla's Questions

- 1. What would be the ideal work hours for this position?
- 2. What skills would this role consist and/or not consist of?
- 3. Where would we utilize them in the department if we bring this role back?
- 4. How would bringing this role back help our productivity as well as our LWBS numbers?

Kayla and Renee's collaboration:

- 1. Since moving our mid-levels to triage from 12p-12a, we could utilize the paramedic to work alongside the mid-level to perform orders to begin work-ups in the lobby when no beds are readily available. The paramedics will be scheduled 7am-7pm and 7pm-7am. This will allow them to care for lower acuity patients when there is not a midlevel.
- 2. Skills they could perform:
 - a. IVs and blood draws (No EJs)
 - b. EKG
 - c. Medications administration (No IV antibiotics, RSI medications, or ACLS medications)
 - d. Assist with transporting ICU patients
- 3. Their main responsibility is to partner with the midlevel provider and assist the throughput in the waiting room.
- 4. This will help lower the LWBS numbers as the patients in the lobby will be seen, treated and discharged.
