 - Delegating to PCT's to pass water out to patients every four hours with vital signs to improve hydration status
 - Delegating to Sue to stock hand sanitizers for patient use that will be stocked in nurse servers for nurses and PCT's to offer to patients
 - Overseeing that all discharge paperwork gets printed as opposed to being copied, this will provide our patients with a professional clean copy.
- Make sure all boxes are complete on post fall form. We need to send back if incomplete
- There should not be any extra linen in any of the rooms
- Please pick up all empty or old cups and dishes in the rooms
- If you reschedule a medication, please let the oncoming nurse know
- Charting refusal for SCD's is false documentation if patient did not refuse
- PCT's empty foley catheters and purewick canisters at change of shift
- Fill out communication boards completely during bedside shift report
- Every nurse and PCT must complete bedside shift report at the bedside
- Every patient who has had ortho or neuro surgery must be up by 6:45 am
- Breakfast trays should be on this floor by 0705 everyday, if not, notify Barbara
- We are having the mock survey soon, let's keep our unit clean and organized
- All PCT's will have a key to the bottom drawer
- To reduce falls, do not leave patients alone in the restrooms or at the bedside commode. "Safety is within arms reach, we have to stay, not go away.
- Post-op vitals include: BP, HR, RR, and temperature
- Tag all IV tubing with appropriate label stickers
- Patient armbands are not allowed on keyboards
