We found stage 2 yesterday that was hospital acquired so we're going to review the RCA process. Also found out there's a diagnosis code for multisystem failure, so some data reported previously was partly because of covid patients' facial wounds that required hospital so we're looking into starting that code when applicable.</p> <p>Diagnosis code for Covid patients.</p> <p>Eric Riggan, new wound care nurse, Wound Wednesdays reimplemented, starting trial next week (he'll measure, take photos, & paired with float PCT).
